## COUNSELOR'S CORNER

Counseling classes are using Talking About Touching: A Personal Safety Curriculum. The program teaches children skills that will help keep them safe from dangerous or abusive situations. Children also learn to ask for help when they need it. Kindergarten has already started this program and parents have been receiving letters keeping them informed about the current lessons.

The first grade through fourth grade program is divided into three units:

**Personal Safety.** This unit teaches children rules that will help keep them safe in potentially dangerous situations. Lessons include car, traffic, fire, and gun safety.

**Touching Safety.** This unit focuses on teaching children to identify unsafe touches and to say “No,” get away, and tell a grown-up if someone tries to touch their private body parts. Children are also taught not to keep secrets about touching.

**Assertiveness and Support.** This unit gives children a chance to practice getting out of unsafe situations and to ask a grown-up for help if they need it.

You will receive a series of letters throughout the year that provide information about how you can help your child learn and practice safety rules taught in counseling classroom lessons. Children learn more about safety and are more likely to follow safety rules when they have multiple opportunities to practice and talk about safety with their family. 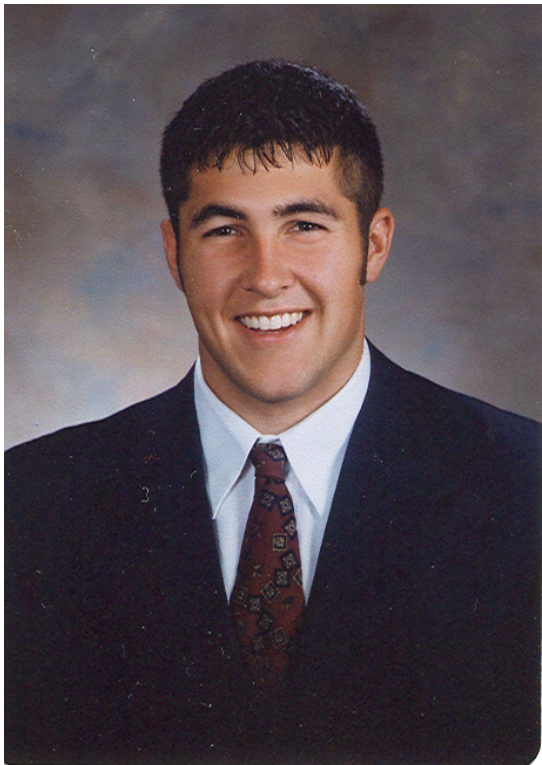
