## KAFCS Teacher of the Year-2007

Kathryn J. Roberts, CFCS, Beloit, KS, was presented the Teacher of the Year award by the Kansas Association of Family & Consumer Sciences at their recent state conference. This award recognized Kathryn's outstanding performance as a Family and Consumer Sciences teaching professional and her contributions toward the leadership of the KAFCS organization.

Currently, **Kathryn is the Family & Consumer Sciences teacher for grades 7-12 at Concordia Junior Senior High School.** She provides eight course offerings as well as serving as FCCLA Advisor. Her program focus areas within her field include Career Awareness and Job Skill training.

Before coming to Concordia High School, Kathryn was employed by USD #273 for 27 years at the Beloit Juvenile Correctional Facility where she served as FACS instructor in grades 7- 12. She provided individualized instruction and curriculum development based on individual student needs. She implemented general FCS and vocational courses including Food Service, Custodial training and the recently adopted ProStart Culinary Arts program through the National Restaurant Association Educational Foundation.

While at Beloit Correctional Facility, Kathryn's goal was to provide each individual the knowledge and tools to obtain employment and become productive citizens when they returned to their home communities while meeting the challenges and obstacles of residing in a correctional environment.

Kathryn holds a Masters degree in Special Education from Kansas State University and a dual Bachelors degree in Home Economics Education and Extension, also from Kansas State University.

During her twenty years of membership in both the American Association of Family & Consumer Sciences and the Kansas chapter, she has served in many leadership roles. Previously, she served as Secretary, Treasurer, President-Elect and as President of the Kansas Association of Family & Consumer Sciences. She, also, served the KAFCS organization as newsletter editor for six years. Presently, she serves as a trustee on the Kansas Association of Family and Consumer Sciences Foundation and was elected as the foundation's president for the upcoming year.

She also holds memberships in the K-State Alumni Association and Beta Sigma Phi.

The KAFCS organization is pleased to recognize the contributions Kathryn Roberts has made both to the individuals she has taught through her career and to the leadership she has provided for the Family & Consumer Sciences profession.

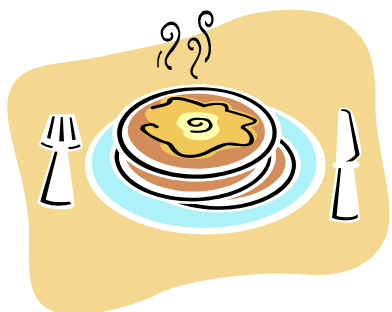
This field trip corresponds with the current Kansas History curriculum that has been implemented in the seventh grade social studies classroom.

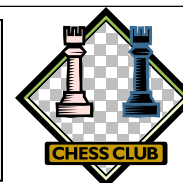
